## Information

---

**Enrollment/Reenrollment Fee** - This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

**SEVIS I-901 Fee** - International students who plan to study at Horizon Christian School are considered as an F-1 status. All F-1 Status students must pay the 1-90 fee to the government (U.S. Immigration & Customs Enforcement) in support of the Student Exchange Visitors Program (SEVP). This must be done before your visa appointment with the American Consulate. Please visit this website for more information and to pay this fee. <http://www.ice.gov/sevis/i901/index.htm>

**International Tuition** - Tuition includes grade-level activity fees, one sports fee, and yearbooks for either middle or high school. Tuition also includes English proficiency testing one time each year for all students. Diploma students will also receive a Chromebook with their tuition.

**Medical Insurance** - All students are required to have medical insurance and must provide proof if they bring their own insurance.

**Host Family Placement Fee for Returning Students** - This \$200 fee covers the host family application process and administration fees for placing students. This fee is waived if a student has made arrangements with their own host family. If a student chooses to move to another host family, an additional \$200 fee will be charged.

**Host Family Stipend** - This fee is paid to the school for 10 months. The school will distribute the funds to the host family.

**New Student Orientation Fee** - All new high school students are required to attend this orientation. Orientation is approximately one week and will be held at the high school campus. During orientation, students take placement tests and meet with teachers and fellow American students. It allows new students to prepare for class and meet new friends.

**ESL Support** - For students at the high school who need additional English support, ESL Bible, ESL1 and ESL2 are offered for the first year. Each student is evaluated individually during orientation to determine if ESL support is necessary.

## Other Fees

---

**English Tutoring** - Available for students who need extra help. Cost varies depending on frequency and length of sessions.

**English Proficiency Test** - One English Proficiency test per year is included in tuition and fees. Students must pay an additional fee if they take more than one test per year.

**Incidental Fees** - Incidental fees are fees charged to students for circumstances of damaged or lost books/school materials or damage to the school property.

**Promotion and Graduation Fees** - 8th grade promotion fee is \$50. 12th grade graduation fee is \$150.

**Sports Fee** - One sports fee is included in tuition. Students participating in more than one sport will need to pay \$150 for middle school and \$300 for high school for each additional sport. This fee will be paid to the athletic department.

**Postage/Handling Fee** - For students requesting a yearbook mailed to their home country, there will be a required postage fee that needs to be paid to the school. This fee will depend on the U.S. Postal Service international shipping rates for that country.

**Lunch Fee** - Horizon Christian School does not offer a hot lunch program. At the high school, a student store is available to purchase some convenient snacks and small lunch items.

## Making Payments

---

Two choices are available for tuition and fee payments:

1. Full payment due by July 1st
2. Semester payments:
  - 1st payment due by July 1st
  - 2nd payment due by January 1st

Students may not participate in class if tuition and fees are not paid. Once a student begins class, tuition for that semester is not refundable.
